**What is this about?** A settlement has been reached with the City of Calverton Park and Code Enforcement Officer Sean Gibbons (“Defendants”) in a class action lawsuit alleging that Defendants violated the U.S. Constitution by towing vehicles from private residences without notice and for issuing Special Tax Bills for costs allegedly associated with the cost of the tow.

**Who is included?** The Settlement Class includes persons whose vehicles were towed from their private residence by the City of Calverton Park for alleged violations of a municipal nuisance ordinance or who paid Special Tax Bills for a towed vehicle between September 25, 2018, and June 26, 2025. You received this Notice because records indicate that you may have been an occupant or owner of a home from which a vehicle was towed or you were a recent owner of record of a towed vehicle. This Notice is to inform you of your rights and options under the terms of a proposed settlement.

**What does the Settlement provide?** Defendant will create a \$465,000 Settlement Fund to compensate Settlement Class Members who complete and submit a Claim Form by September 4, 2026. If you are a Class Member and you chose to complete and submit a Claim Form, you will receive a payment by check or a selected alternative electronic method for your portion of the Settlement, once the Court approves the Settlement and after Court-approved deductions for attorneys’ fees and costs, administrative costs, and service awards are made.

**What are my options?** (1) **Do Nothing:** If you do nothing you will not receive a Settlement payment, and your rights will be affected. You will be bound by the Court’s decisions and you will release any claim that you may have concerning a towed vehicle or Special Tax Bill payment. (2) **Submit a Claim Form:** To receive a Settlement payment you must file a claim. You can complete and return the Claim Form attached to this Notice by mail or submit one online at [www.CalvertonParkClassAction.com](http://www.CalvertonParkClassAction.com). Claim Forms must be submitted by September 4, 2026. (3) **Request Exclusion:** If you do not want to be legally bound by the Settlement or receive a check, you must opt out from the Settlement by June 22, 2026. (4) **Object.** If you do not like the Settlement, you may write to the Court explaining why you object to it. An objection must be filed by August 21, 2026. The Court will hold a Final Approval Hearing at 11:00 am on Sept. 18, 2026 in Courtroom 16N, at the Thomas F. Eagleton United States Courthouse, 111 S. 10<sup>th</sup> St., St. Louis, MO, 63102, to consider whether to approve the Settlement, Class Counsel’s request for attorneys’ fees and expenses, and the plaintiffs’ service awards. You may attend but are not required to do so. Settlement Payments cannot be issued until after the Court approves the Settlement. Be advised that the Final Approval Hearing date may change without further notice to Class Members.
